A note from the President: Hello, Members, the annual TWL Picnic is almost here. This year we're planning another great day full of activities for all ages. We're going to have great music, great food, cold beer and, most importantly, there'll be lots of friends you only get to see once a year. This year we're asking our members for their help in improving the experience. Our Grounds Keeper will be available to identify alternate parking & transportation. Finally; it is very important that you do not block, or obstruct any roadway. If you encroach in any way, you will be asked to move your vehicle. Thanks for your help and cooperation.

Profit or loss on our picnic has always been determined by our raffle. If you can't attend the picnic, please participate in our raffle. You don't need to be present to win the three big prizes. Any additional donations you wish to make will be gladly accepted. Security procedures will remain the same for 2019.

- Friday and Saturday all members and guests must sign in at the office. Guests must have their hosting member present to register. At that time ID will be checked for legal drinking age and a wristband will be issued with guests name and card number of the hosting member. Everyone in attendance Friday or Saturday must register. This includes members and guests not participating in the picnic. If you register on Friday you will not need to re-register on Saturday as long as you have your wristband on. This will insure the attendance of only members and their intended guests. Bring your identification!
- To help with congestion at the gate on Saturday, 2 vehicle passes are enclosed for your guests. Give a pass to your guests that will be arriving on Saturday. This will allow controlled access without having to lock the gate and won't require you going to the gate to let them in. If you need to enter on Saturday just show your key card, you don't need a pass for yourself.
- For the safety of all, access will be denied to <u>ALL</u> incoming traffic at 12:00 noon on Saturday. Members and guests arriving from Noon to 5:00 p.m. will be provided parking outside the gate on Finck Road. The hayride will pick up inside the gate.
- To eliminate the long waits at the ticket window there will be 2 lines this year 1 line for prepaid orders and 1 line for day of picnic purchases. If you purchase your tickets in advance you will not only save money, you will wait in a much shorter line as well.

Our picnic cannot happen without <u>YOUR</u> participation. Last year many of our volunteering members worked all day and into the night to make the picnic the success that it has always been. We need the help and support of all our members to make the picnic safe and enjoyable for us all. There will be sign-up sheets at the wrist banding areas. If each member would donate 2 hours on Friday or Saturday the rest of us could spend time with our families as well. All time worked will count toward your annual workday requirements.

Please remember that each member is responsible for the conduct of each of his or her guests. We all want to have a good time. Protect your memberships. Familiarize yourselves with the Ground Rules. Finally; keep your speed at or under 5 MPH. We have many little ones dashing around that count on you to use good judgment!

We do advise you to keep your freshwater tanks full. Due to increasing power costs, watering must be done on nights and weekends. Do not move or turn off water without the permission of the Groundskeeper.
